Apply for grants to help us accomplish vaccine equity

We need your help to meet [the vaccine equity goals we set](#) on May 28, 2021.

Community partners serving Clackamas County, including 501c3 nonprofits and faith-based communities, can apply for up to \$30,000 per organization.

The grant funding should be used to:

- Focus on communities with the lowest rates of vaccination (people who are Black, indigenous or Latinx; low-income or houseless; have disabilities or mental illness; or who live in rural areas)
- Educate and build vaccine confidence through community outreach
- Increase access to vaccination opportunities through hosting or customizing events or arranging transportation

Applications can be submitted anytime through October 1, 2021. Applicants must submit a project narrative, budget and proof of insurance.

The grant amounts will depend on the number of applications we receive. The \$1.1 million in funds, provided by the Oregon Health Authority, must be spent by December 30, 2021.
